To whom it may concern;

On 1/27/2023 I performed a health inspection on an 9 year old Kentucky Mountain Horse mare named Grace. She is bay in color. She was quiet and cooperative during the inspection. Her feet were picked up and handled for hoof tester exam with no resistance. She had no negative response to hoof testers applied to all four feet. She showed no lameness at a running walk on firm surface. She was wearing shoes on front feet during the inspection.

She was auscultated while at rest. Her heart and lungs auscultated normal at this time heart rate was 24 BPM and breathing was 12 BPM and clear. She had normal gut sounds in all abdominal quadrants. There is no evidence of previous colic surgery. Her eyes were clear and responsive. Her ears were very attentive. Her ears were handled with no reaction and no head "shyness". Her rectal temperature was 99.7 during the inspection.

A quick check of her teeth more closely matched 9 years of age based on tooth eruption and dental wear. Her body condition score on this day is 6 on a scale of 1-9.

She was not pregnancy checked or checked for breeding soundness at this time.

This inspection represents the findings on this day and does not represent a guarantee of any type from Dr. Bundy. This is a health inspection and by no means represents a pre purchase exam (PPE). Nor does it take the place of findings on a pre purchase exam. Future owners will want to talk with their veterinarian and plan for the required health care of their new horse. Vaccinations, fecal floatation, deworming, and dental procedures will be left up to his or her recommendations.
